**Bettolino Kitchen:** Redondo Beach hasn't had a compelling restaurant since Hudson House opened years ago, but this sweetly designed room gives the South Bay an extra dose of culinary action. Vince and Andreanna Giulano, along with Sean Liguore, have imported Italian chef Fabio Ugoletti to prepare handmade pastas like lasagnetta with

porcini, fresh herbs, and a hint of cocoa powder, or the ravioli del plin, using chicken and herb stuffed pasta, criminis, and shrimp in a light cream sauce. With just 65 seats, it's a tough table to land. 211 Palos Verdes Blvd, Redondo Beach, CA 90277. (310) 375-0500.
