**Bettolino Kitchen:** Brother and sister duo Vince Giuliano and Andreanna Giuliano Liguore, who come from a long line of Italian restaurant owners (their grandfather owned Giuliano's in Gardena way back, and the family still operates Geatano's Torrance), have debuted another Italian spot in the South Bay. Now open in Redondo Beach, Bettolino's features a menu from chef Fabio Ugoletti, a recent transplant from Florence, Italy, including his handmade pastas, fried meatballs with spicy tomato sauce, smoked white fish sandwiches at lunch, and more.
